

EXPORT CACAU POWER MASK

Method of use

STEP 0 – Hair Diagnose

- Deep moisturizing, nutritive and repair treatment
- Suitable for all kind of hair, especially for bleached, blond or damaged hair
- Recommended for **repair, moisturize and control frizz**
- Results: **extra soft, moisturized and healthy hair**

STEP 1 – Deep Cleansing Shampoo

- Wash hair with the shampoo and leave on for **5 minutes** (exactly)
- Rinse with plenty of water
- Repeat this process 2 or 3 times minimum, until the hair is very clean and has an almost rough touch
- Remove dampness with a towel (**Do not use a hairdryer**)
- Tips for a perfect wash:
 - Do not rub hair roots too much
 - Massage the entire length of hair
 - Pay special attention to the back of the neck

STEP 2 – Power Mask (optional Hair Oil, Ampoules C, K or H)

- **Vigorously shake** the treatment bottle (important)
- Use gloves, a bowl and a palette
- Put **30-50g** in the bowl, depending on the length/thickness of the hair
- Mix with other Export products to achieve an:
 - Extra antifrizz and repairing result: add **1/2 ampoule C of cacau** and mix
 - Extra reconstructive result: add **3ml of the ampoule K of keratin** and mix
 - Extra shiny result: add **3ml of the ampoule H of hyaluronic acid** and mix
 - Extra hydrating result: add 3 drops of Export Hair Oil

- Make partitions on damp hair
- Apply the treatment with the pallet, grabbing fine locks of hair
- Start with the back of the neck at 1 cm of the root
- Use enough product to cover all the lock
- Run a fine comb to remove the excess
- The exposure time is **30 minutes**
- Rinse hair only with water, removing all the product
- Detangle hair, make partitions and divide hair in fine locks
- Grab a comb and start drying with a hairdryer
- **Make a perfect brushing**, starting on the back of the neck and pull the hair locks, until it is fully dried and well-aligned
- **It is optional to use the iron**
- Prepare the straightener between 180-230° according to the hair:
 - Thin, bleached and damaged hair: **180°C**
 - Normal hair: **200°C**
 - Thick and resistant hair: **230°C**
- Make partitions and divide hair in fine locks in order to straighten it (the hair has to touch the straightener on the upper and the lower part)
- Start on the back of the neck and run **1-2 times** each lock according to the type of hair
- In very damaged ends, run less times
- Finish with **Export Hair Oil** in the ends

TIPS – Last Recommendations

- It is possible to wash the same day with a salt-free shampoo (Sodium Chloride)
- For longer lasting results, use the **Export Home Care** line
